God continues to bless our family. Our grandson, Josiah Silas King was born October 27, 2008 in Fredericksburg, Virginia. He is the sweetest little boy in the whole wide world. Brian King, our son-in-law is doing a ministry internship with the Spotsylvania church of Christ. Brian and Melissa have joined up with another family to go to Brazil. Nick, Amy and Jonah Fowler have been planning for a long time to go with a mission team to Brazil. The Fowlers and Kings want to recruit other families to go with them. At this point, all of them plan to move to Lubbock in August so they can recruit more effectively. They plan to go to SIBI School of missions together starting August 10 through December 18, 2009.



During Sunset's 3rd term (January 12 through March 13, 2009), I taught Evangelistic Methods course together with Jerry Tallman to the level one students. Also during that term I taught Mission Evangelism to the Adventures in Missions class and Topical Preaching lab with Level one. This term (4th term is March 30 through May 29, 2009), I teacher in the Evangelistic Preaching lab. Also I'm working on the campaign follow up and preparing for the Summer Brazil mission trip.

Charles Speer and I organized the week-long "Heart to Heart Outreach" (Lubbock campaign) this year, March 23-28, 2009 (Monday-Saturday). It was a required campaign for all level one and

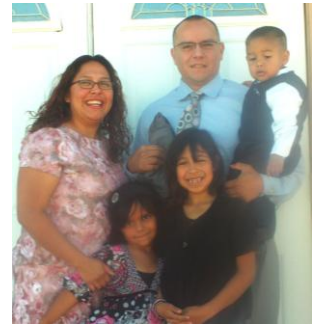

level two students. Each one of us, both faculty and students, pared up and adopted a street. We walked our street and prayed for each household. We left a card with a different message on it for 3 days. On Thursday and Friday we knocked on each door and gave them 2 more cards and talked to them and tried to set up Bible studies. Lots of Bible studies were set up and

many of them still continue. One has already been baptized.

I am planning to take another mission trip to Brazil this summer just like I have been doing for most of the last 13 years. I try to take students with me and try to convince them to do mission work in Brazil. I recently received the Aracajú Brazil – Five year Report. Several students in the past have gone with me to Aracajú and now one (Randy Warzecha) has been working there for over five years. Consider the value of this kind of mission trip by seeing the actual results given by the power of God. Please see his Five-Year Report (attached). Much of the funds for this mission trip have already been raised and some has been promised. I still need to raise \$3150. Three families will be going and 9 tickets have already been bought. Those going are: Brian, Melissa, and Josiah King; Nick, Amy and Jonah Fowler (all 6 pictured above) and John and Becky Fernandez. Their kids Lea, Mia, and Johnny will stay with grandparents in Houston.

We plan to do a 2-week campaign in Salvador, Brazil, a one-week campaign in Aracajú, Brazil and survey the cities of **São Luis Brazil (a city of 1,256,000 where no work of the church of Christ is known)**, and **Belem, Brazil (a city of over 2 million where no work of the church of Christ is known)**.

Thank you all so much for your concern, love, sacrificial support and prayers. Please continue to pray for us, for our students here, for those going to Brazil and ask our Father to grant abundant fruit for our work. Pray that the Lord of harvest will send out reapers into the fields that are white. **Pray that reapers (including you and me), will boldly and wisely plant the Gospel in good soil (hearts).**
