CHURCH PLANTINGS

Contact with members of the church in Borneo Needed

We are looking for contacts in the major cities of Samarinda and Balikpapan. These contacts would be members of the church working for oil or mining companies in these cities of East Kalimantan on the island of Borneo. We have planted the church in West Kalimantan in the capital city of Pontianak and would now like to expand the evangelism to the eastern province in the capital city of **Samarinda** and the industrial city of **Balik Papan**.



The Lord has opened another door to the island of **Nusa Tenggara Timur** in the capital city of **Kupang**. Brother Yonthan my assistant director of Mission Indonesia called me last month and asked me if we could plant the church in the city of Kupang in Timur. He told me that a convert from Sulawesi had returned home to Kupang and desired to have the church there. We talked about it and have formed an initial plan of work to enter this area with the goal of planting the church on this island. However, the age old problem of missions is the lack of funds to do the work of the Lord. This is an opportunity for a congregation or even a bible class to sponsor a mission team to plant the church where it doesn't exist at this time. Right now it will cost about \$700.00 a month to enter the city of Kupang but this will increase as we add to the team of missionaries and expand the work. **The Lord is Calling Will You Answer!**
