Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I deeply appreciate your hospitality, contributions and prayers from all of you for our efforts in taking the gospel of Christ to Indonesia. I am thankful for all your efforts and help in my fund raising efforts this year. I pray that we will never have an any shortage of funds again like we experienced this year. Besides the shortage of funds, this year has already been quite successful by any standard.

Our primary goal each year is to plant new churches throughout the country. This year we have planted six new congregations through the students who have graduated from Batam Bible College. The new churches were planted in Central Java, North Sumatra, Central Sulawesi, and West Kalimantan. This translates into over 160 baptisms so far this year.

The Batam Bible College instructors will begin their training for thesis writing starting November 2, and it will last through the month of November. Once the training is finished they will write a thesis to complement their Bachelors degree in Biblical Studies from Sunset International Bible Institute. This will qualify them to proceed to acquiring their Masters degree within the next three years. This will not only fulfill a government requirement but also give them the status that translates into influence when they present seminars throughout the country.

We still need your help to fulfill requirement of having a minimum of three thousand books in our library. I am happy to report that that my goal of finishing my dissertation for a Doctorate in Missions is done. I send the complete draft of 283 pages earlier this week and am waiting for the evaluation and final defense. This is the final step in satisfying all the accreditation requirements for the school as far as I am concerned.

The one goal that keeps eluding me is a sponsoring congregation for myself. No fund raising involved. The following is what being a sponsor for Winston Bolt involves:

- **MISSION COORDINATOR** - with a power of attorney to sign checks, tax forms, and any other legal documents. Coordinating payments for health insurance, retirement and other needs.
- **ACCOUNTING** - keeping track of funds received and sent, filing tax forms, and Social Security taxes.
- **FUNDS** - contributing a minimum of \$15,000 to my salary per year and receiving funds for my salary and mission teams. Full support would be fine also but not a requirement.
- **TRANSPORTATION AND HOUSING** - this simply entails having a vehicle available for fund-raising and housing when I first arrive in the States and before I return to Indonesia, which usually entails three to four weeks. Staying with one family is best.
- **INVOLVEMENT** - visitation or participation in someway with the work.

I pray that the Lord blesses all who are now participating in taking the gospel to Indonesia and that He will provide a sponsoring congregation that desires to share in this work with me. Taking the Gospel of Christ into all of Indonesia is no small task and it takes the whole church to get it done.
